

## Varicella (Chicken Pox) Requirements for School Attendance

As of September, 2007, **all 9<sup>th</sup>, 10<sup>th</sup>, 11<sup>th</sup>, 1<sup>st</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> grade** students will be required to have documentation of either having had varicella (chicken pox), or varicella immunization.

### Your child will be required to have one of the following:

- A note from the student's physician stating that your child has had chickenpox.
- Documentation that your child has had the varicella (chickenpox) vaccine.
- Results of a blood test that shows your child is immune to chickenpox.
- A signed parental/guardian waiver form or letter, that indicates your sincere religious belief or philosophical reason for not immunizing your child. A letter from your child's healthcare provider explaining the medical reason for not getting immunized.
